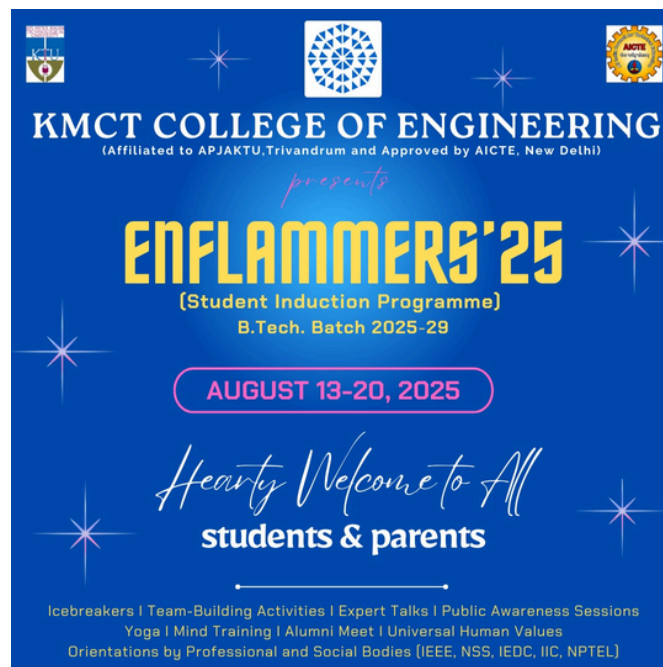

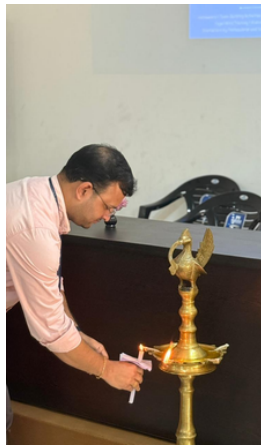


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⚡ KSEB Energy Quiz – Promoting Energy Awareness

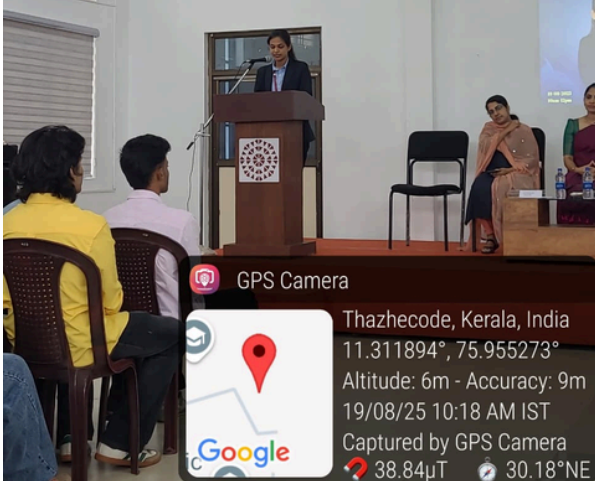
Relaunch of Avenue- HR Club at KMCT School of Business

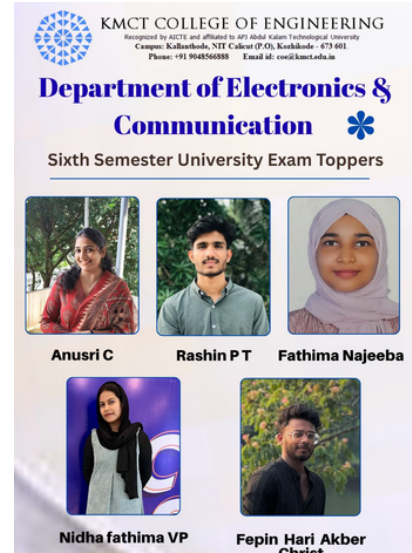
