## NSS Volunteers Donate Blood at MVR Cancer Center



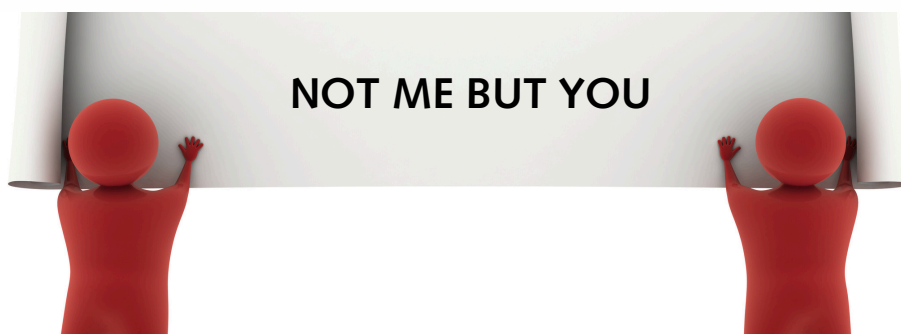

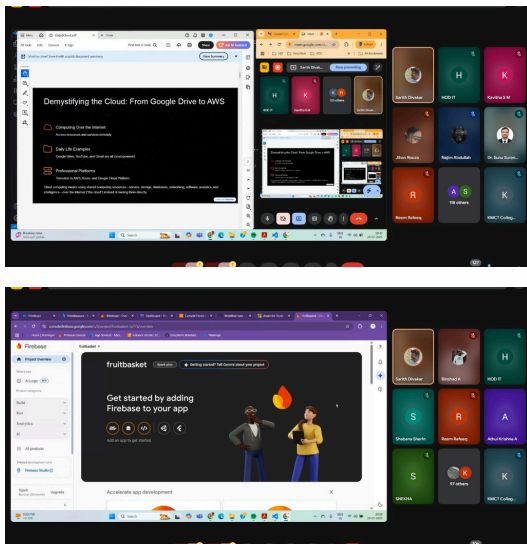

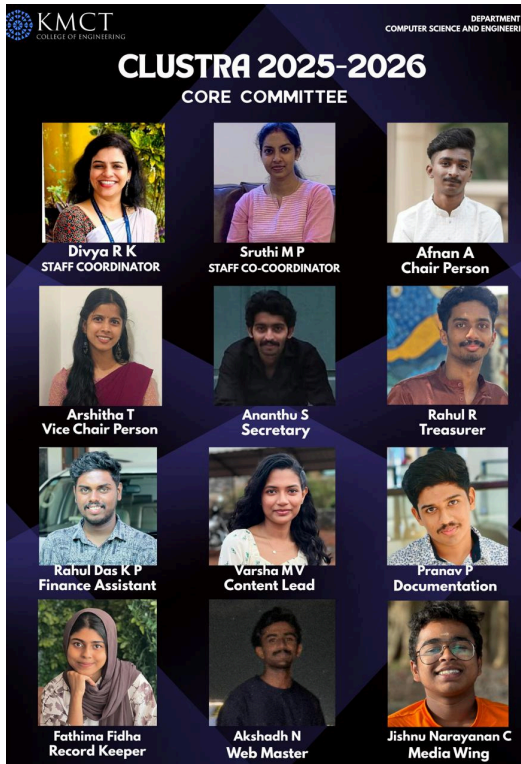
## CLUSTRA 2025 Logo Design Contest: A Stage for Innovation and Imagination

## ELECTRA Core Committee Announced for 2025

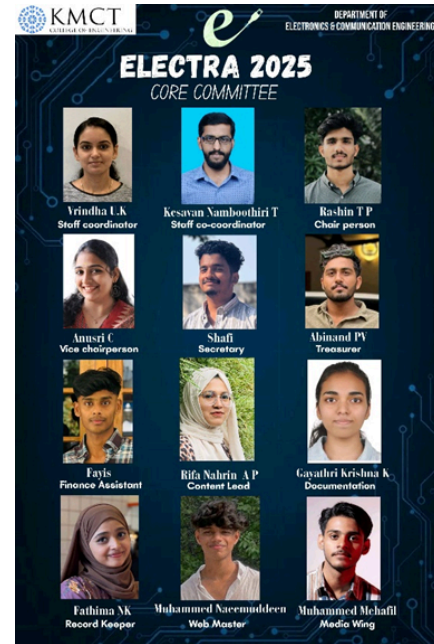

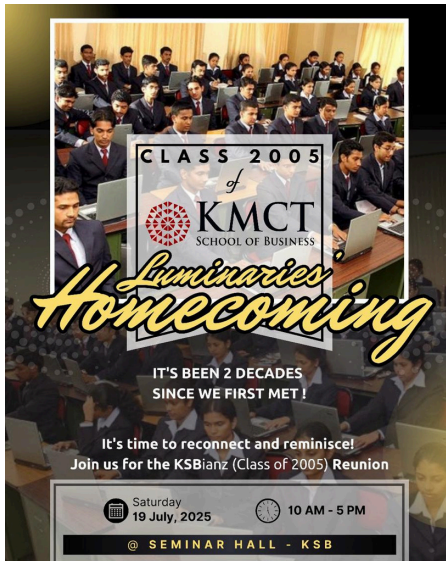
